

REALTIME HOOKUP USING BRIDGE MOBILE (WITH ROUTER) AND STENOCAST RED

ECLIPSE v.7

Court Reporter's Computer

Prior to Realtime Session

Download CM Local to desktop (www.eclipsecat.com)

Download Stenocast Red drivers (www.stenocast.com)

Realtime Session Setup

Plug Stenocast Red into computer

Plug router into computer

Boot computer

Click on "CM Local" on your desktop – Write down IP address from browser bar –
Minimize CM window

Start Eclipse – Alt U – Click on "Advanced" (at the bottom of the box) – Click on
"Connection Magic" – Change dropdown menu to LAN: 4020 (You should only have to
do this once)

Alt U – Realtime Tab – "Output Formats" Dropdown Menu – Bridge/Mobile. "COM
Device" Dropdown Menu – Connection Magic. "Setup" button - Change the COM port
to match the Stenocast Red COM port (Device Manager) – Add baud rate of
38000/38600 (whichever "38000" shows up in your choices)

RECEIVING COMPUTER USING STENOCAST RED AND BRIDGE (NOT BRIDGE MOBILE) ON COMPUTER

Download Stenocast Red drivers (make sure they are the most current drivers)

Load Bridge software (www.eclipsecat.com)

Insert dongle (Red for refresh)

Open Bridge – Click on "Settings" – Change COM port to match Stenocast Red COM port
(Device Manager) – Set baud rate at 38000/38600 (whichever "38000" shows up in
your choices)

STARTING REALTIME SESSION

COURT REPORTER AND RECEIVING COMPUTER (Not a tablet device) – Start realtime
translation as usual. A Bridge Mobile box will pop up when your file opens. If desired,
change the name of your job to your preference. Type in a password of your choosing,
but remember the password. Stroke something on your machine or start your VOX.

The Connection Magic box will pop up with your file name. Click "Connect" (the lightning bolt) in Bridge Mobile. Have them type in the password you used on your computer. Your realtime should appear on their screen.

COURT REPORTER AND RECEIVING TABLET DEVICE – Start realtime translation as usual. A Bridge Mobile box will pop up when your file opens. If desired, change the name of your job to your preference. Type in a password of your choosing, but remember the password. Stroke something on your machine or start your VOX. Have the person with the tablet device type in the IP address from your Connection Magic box into their browser bar. (Do not type "www" or "http://") It will look something like "192.168.100.101/bridge" Be sure you type in the extension "/bridge") The Connection Magic box will pop up with your file name. Click "Connect" (the lightning bolt) in Bridge Mobile. Have them type in the password you used on your computer. Your realtime should appear on their screen.
